

HOW TO CREATE A BEE BATH



You will need:



- x1 2L Arla Big Milk bottle
- Scissors (to be used under parental guidance only)
- Masking tape
- Mixture of large and small stones
- Water

Pollinators like bees and butterflies seek out water. They get thirsty, so a bee bath is the perfect way to give them a well-earned drink and rest. We're going to make a bee bath.

Top Tip — have some fun with painting a few of the stones too!

Instructions:



- Use masking tape to tape a line around the bottle so you have a straight line to cut — place the tape towards bottom of the bottle — the bee bath needs to be shallow, so bear this in mind!



- Using scissors, carefully cut around the masking tape so you're left with the bottom of the bottle.
- Add your stones and rocks to the base of the bottle — this will weigh it down and make it secure for bees and insects to visit.



- Add in your water — don't overfill the base as bees need shallow water.



- Make sure some of your pebbles and stones are above the water — this will provide bees with a vantage point to drink without falling in.
- Place in dappled shade if possible and watch the bees visit!
